## Chicken bounty posed

The explosion of Grand Cayman's wild chicken population could prompt authorities to offer a bounty on them as a control measure.

"There are opinions about the over-population of chickens - if we can find an element in society, someone who has the experience in catching these chickens and getting them to eat, we would encourage that," said Chief Agricultural and Veterinary Officer Alfred Benjamin in an interview with the *Compass* Wednesday. "In the mean time we're trying to find creative means to deal with it, like putting out bounties on them."

Dr. Benjamin indicated that he might consider recommending that government offer a prize per head to people taking chickens "off the streets". He also suggested they be consumed as food.

"They're a good source of protein and safe to eat," he said.

Dr. Benjamin offered several possible explanations as to why this over-population has occurred. The abandonment of chickens imported for the Agriculture Show is one, as well as those raised in camps on personal properties.

He suggested that people have stopped raising chickens
